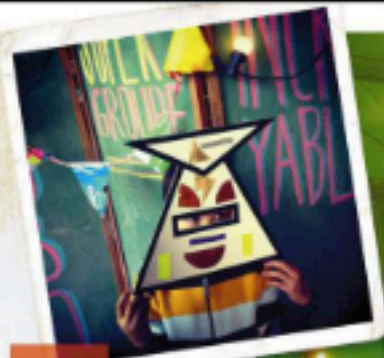

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## WANDERLUST, PARIS

**Concert space + sports centre +  
nightclub + cinema + restaurant**

This is last summer's hit Left Bank opening from the team behind David Lynch's Silencio club, and it hosts everything from food markets and kite-making workshops for children to yoga classes on its huge terrace (the biggest in Paris). Inside, the funky space houses a nightclub, a restaurant serving snacky bits and bobs from hip Paris chef David Arnaud and high-profile fashion events, all of which have helped lure a new generation to the once-forsorn 13th arrondissement. 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## DUDELL'S, HONG KONG

**Gallery + bar/restaurant + terrace**

Globe-trotting British designer Ise Crawford is behind the transformation of the upper floors of this Central building (which also contains Shanghai Tang's flagship store) into something resembling the private home of an eclectic art dealer, albeit one with a Michelin-standard chef (Siu Hin Chi) in the kitchen.

The art on show at this month-old creative hub ranges from 20th-century ink-brush paintings to international works selected by guest curators. The huge rooftop terrace is set to become the go-to spot for artisanal-cocktail sipping and summer film screenings.
