BLUE ROOM

Architecture practice Softroom has provided a new reason to visit the British Museum's Great Court. The firm's crescent-shaped design for the recently opened Benugo restaurant wraps around an open kitchen, where dishes inspired by the museum's current exhibitions are prepared. Design details include bentwood chairs by UK company Benchmark, floor lights by Swedish brand Orsjö Belysning that echo the lines of the court's Ionic columns, and turquoise Knoll upholstery that mirrors the colour of the sky seen through Foster and Partners' latticed glass ceiling (britishmuseum.org; softroom.com).
