396 (USA) BRETTON BED

Bretton Bed is named after the town in West Yorkshire, England, a county that inspires Matthew Hilton, with its rugged landscape and history of producing modernist sculptors. The bed features meticulous detailing including a headboard that tapers toward the bed base, mitre joints in the corners of the platform, and a beautiful combination of materials. Designed by Matthew Hilton for his eponymous brand, and manufactured by De La Espada craftsmen.

NOTE 1: The Bretton legs are made from gravity die-cast aluminium and contain small defects that are inherent to the artisanal
